

#### **Job Summary**

The role of the Specialist Engineer is to complete installation activities (installing, servicing and defleeting) of various Telematics on Board Units (OBU) in vehicles owned or operated by customers of Trak Global Security Solutions. Primarily these vehicles are in the fleet, rental, mobility and insurance sectors. Installation activity typically takes place at customer premises and regional vehicle storage centres.

- Vehicle Maintenance:
  - Ensure company vehicle is regularly maintained and serviced.
  - o Promptly report any fault codes or mechanical issues to management.
- Data Recording: Accurately document installation details to support effective tracking and reporting.
- Issue Reporting: Report any operational issues or incidents to management immediately.
